Chesterfield Lying at the head of Chester River
On the N.W. branch of the same River. Began
at a marked Red Oak. Standing in a fork of the
said Branch And running from the said Oak E. with
the Branch 320 ff. and with a line drawn from the
end of the E. line N. 250 ff. and with a line drawn
from the end of the N. line W. 320 ff. And with a line
drawn from the end of the W. line S. to the first
marked Oak. 250 ff. Cont. 500 Acres
