Begun at marked Poplar being the first bounded tree
 of y^e land formerly laid out for James four bush
 by the French side and running for 1/2 mile N 82 W
 to the S land of 40 1/2 Alexander called y^e four bush
 12 1/2 to a marked white oak - in y^e road to y^e farm
 the land is here oak - by a line drawn 26 1/2 for
 length 320 and from y^e end of y^e 26 1/2 line
 by a line drawn S 82 1/2 W to y^e land of 40 1/2
 James four bush and 15 1/2 of y^e land of 40 1/2
