

To the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Proprietor

This humble memorial sheweth that by virtue of a
warrant of two thousand acres of land granted
to me Philmon Hamly, bearing date the
11th day of April last past & four hundred
twenty five acres thereof assigned to me William
Harris of Kent County: I Philmon Hamly do by
this my memorial sheweth that I have
hand laid out for the said Wm Harris a tract
of land lying & being in Kent County called
the Holy Land lying in Kent County on the
north side of the River in Langfords ba-
and at the head of a creek called Quins be-
ginning at a marked poplar being of first
bound of a tract of land formerly laid
for James King & running thence the sa-
id creek South East one hundred & twenty feet
to a marked oak being a bound thence of a tra-
ct of land formerly laid out for one Spenshaw
thence running East three hundred & eight
feet into the river then north west on a line
& twenty paces to a marked poplar being
by a branch of a tract of land being of first bound thence
of a tract of land laid out for J^o King
called of plain then west & south west fifty
paces then south 100 paces then south East con-
ing & now laid out for four hundred twenty
and five acres more or less to be had of the
manor of Balgonie & June 11th 1699
