

There is a Deed from Henry Cole (Widow) to So. Clayton
dated 16th 7 1730 for 127 acres of Conquest Beg. S
On the West on the S. side of L. River where the S.W.
Line of a tract of Land called Brampton and
run S thence S.W. down with the River
to a pond the S. E. 100 p. then N. 65 to
the S. E. intersects the S. E. tract of Land
and by S with Brampton to the Beg. S
127 acres more or less -

There is a Deed from Same to Same dated 20th
1734 conveying as follows: Viz. all those parts
of Land (that is to say) all the remaining parts
of a tract of Land now remaining unsold called
Brampton lying and being on the S. side of L.
River together with all the remaining part of
a tract of Land called Conquest both moities
(cont. S) by estimation 400. acres of Land more or less.
