Beg. at a Cedar tree at the Mouth of a cove the second  
 boundary of Longquest N.E. 159 p. to Brampton then with  
 that Land S.E. 24 p. then with the said Brampton N. 36  
 E. 104 p. to that part of Smiths mistake sold by Mr  
 Bishop to R. Bennett Esq. then with that part S.E.  
 125 p. to the Land sold by the said Mr. Bishop to  
 Jacob Baily then with that Land N.E. 02 p. to a parcel  
 of Land formerly laid out for John Broadbit called  
 Larrington then with that Land S.E. 20 p. to the end thereof  
 which comes to the place decreed by the Chancellor.  
 Then shape a course to the end of the third line  
 of Costins Hope which course bears S. 5. E distance  
 409 p. to the end of the third line of. then with  
 Costins Land and so on to the Creek and home to the  
 Beg.

 126 p. and S 40 E 125 - S 42 W 14 1/4 p. then S. 40. E. 0 p. to  
 the end of the 30<sup>th</sup> line of a tract called Corsica Farm then with  
 the 39<sup>th</sup> line of a tract still running S 40 E 132 p. and with the  
 30<sup>th</sup> line of a tract N.E. 91 p. to the second line of the origi  
 nal tract called Larrington then with S. line reversed N.  
 40 W. 4 p. to a stone fixed by commission marked with the  
 letter D.
