the General Court the 16th day of April 1788. directed to the

Sheriff and Surveyor of Cecil County to lay down the lands in Controversy for both Plaintiff and defendant as may Appear &c.

I humbly Certify that I have after ten days notice given to the Plaintiff and defendant as directed in the aforesaid Warrant, on the 9th day of February in the presence of the Sheriff and by direction of the Plaintiff Carefully Resurveyed and laid down for Illustration a Tract of Land called the Misfortune, Beginning on a point of Land on the North side of a Creek called Bohemia Back Creek, and on the East side of the Mouth of a Branch called St. Thomas's branch, which Creek and branch were admitted by the defendant Which place Represented on the Plat by the letter A, the Plaintiff alleged to be the place of Beginning of said Tract of Land and running thence up along by the aforesaid Bohemia Back Creek the several Courses thereof Seven hundred and fifty perches to the letter B, on the Plat which the Plaintiff alleged to be at or near the place of the second Original boundary of said Tract of Land then According to the black drawn Lines, and with the Allowance of three degrees and forty five minutes variation on each line, N. E. 320^p to the letter C, then N. W. until it Intersects a line drawn N. E. from the place of Beginning at the letter D. Containing fifteen hundred Acres of Land more or less

Also I have by direction of the Plaintiff in the presence of the Sheriff and defendant Resurveyed and laid down as the Plaintiffs Claim and pretensions part of the aforesaid Tract of Land called the Misfortune which lies to the North Westward of a Creek called Margaritta Creek as mentioned in the deposition of a certain Noble Beedle, which the Plaintiff alleged to be the Land formerly sold by a certain Augustine Herman to a certain Hendrick Matthias, Beginning for the same on the point of Land above mentioned at the mouth of St. Thomas's branch, described on the Plat by the letter A, and running thence up along by the Northerly side of Bohemia Back ^{creek} the several Courses thereof, Three hundred and Eighteen perches to the mouth of the aforesaid Margaritta Creek described on the Plat by the letter E, then up along the North Westerly side of said Creek the several Courses thereof five hundred and sixty seven perches

to the
