

by the letter **T** and running thence according to the black and red dotted lines. $S 25^{\circ} P^{\circ}$ to $N^{\circ} 4$ then returning to the place of beginning and running thence $N 79^{\circ} W 22 p^{\circ}$ $S 89^{\circ} W 32 p^{\circ}$ $N 32^{\circ} W 12 p^{\circ}$ $N 10^{\circ} E 65 p^{\circ}$ to the letter **d**, then $N 67^{\circ} W 14 p^{\circ}$ to the letter **c** then $N 15^{\circ} W 61 p^{\circ}$ to $N^{\circ} 6$ then $S 15^{\circ} W$ until it intersects a line drawn West from the end of the first South twenty five perch line, thereby closing the Resurvey containing Fifty Acres more or less.

I have also by direction of the Defendant in the presence of the Sheriff Resurveyed and laid down said Tract of Land for Illustration called Francis Marsh with an allowance of three Degrees and fifteen Minutes for Variation, Beginning ^{on} at the South Line of the Tract called Triangle (as laid down with like allowance for Variation) at the letter **T** in the Plat and running thence by the Red and Green dotted lines the like courses and Distances as before containing Fifty Acres of Land more or less.

Also I have by direction of the Defendant in the presence of the Sheriff carefully Resurveyed and laid down for Illustration a Tract of Land called Richard's Chance Beginning on a point of Land on the East Side of the Mouth of St Thomas's Branch, and on the North Side of Bohemia Back Creek, which place is alleged by the Defendant to be the place of Beginning of said Tract of Land and is represented on the Plat at the letter **A** and running thence up Bohemia Back Creek according to the red ^{drawn} and Cyphered lines $S 65^{\circ} E 38 p^{\circ}$ $N 33^{\circ} E 64 p^{\circ}$ $S 68^{\circ} E 40 p^{\circ}$ $N 60^{\circ} E 36 p^{\circ}$ $N 83^{\circ} E 16 p^{\circ}$ $N 67^{\circ} E 22 p^{\circ}$ $S 78^{\circ} E 166 p^{\circ}$ to $N^{\circ} 2$ then $N 32^{\circ} E 150 p^{\circ}$ to $N^{\circ} 3$ then $N 15^{\circ} W 137 p^{\circ}$ to $N^{\circ} 4$ then West $120 p^{\circ}$ to $N^{\circ} 5$ and from thence by a straight line to the place of Beginning, containing Three Hundred and thirty five Acres of Land more or less.

Also I have by direction of the Defendant in the presence of the Sheriff Resurveyed and laid down for Illustration said Tract of Land called Richard's Chance with an allowance of three Degrees and Thirty Minutes for Variation, Beginning as before at the letter **A** and running thence up Bohemia Back Creek and according to the red drawn and dotted lines to $N^{\circ} 6$ then to $N^{\circ} 7$, then to $N^{\circ} 8$ then to $N^{\circ} 9$ at a marked white Oak Tree mentioned in the deposition of Noble Biddle and from thence to the place of Beginning containing as before Three Hundred and thirty five Acres of Land more or less.

Also I have by direction of the Defendant in the presence of the Sheriff Resurveyed and laid out for Illustration a Tract of Land called Bristol as Resurveyed in August 1741
