such terms and at such times as shall
be judged reasonable and right by the
High Court of Queen's Bench in
London in respect to the said Bristol
shall have served the said Turbutt as his
due may be done to the wife & children of the
said Bristol and also the said Turbutt Boston
by the service of the said Bristol his wife
& her children agreeable to the spirit &
true intent and meaning of these presents
and the said Turbutt doth consent to treat said
Juda as slave ^{and} ~~is~~ ~~to~~ ~~be~~ ~~treated~~ ~~in~~ ~~this~~ ~~State~~. In Wit-
