

and distances, to wit: Begin-
ning at a Stone standing in
the Edge of the Horse pound and
at the South-East Corner of the
Murry Lot and runs thence North
Sixty six and three quarters
degrees West Fifty six and two
fifths perches to the public road,
then South twenty six and a
half degrees West twenty and
a half perches to that part of the
Harding Land purchased off
of the Bartlett Farm, then with
said Land South forty degrees
East thirty two and six tenths
perches, then South sixty four
and three quarters degrees East
sixty nine perches to the
Upper Heathworth Land, then with
said Land South twenty four and
a half degrees East fifty nine
perches to a Stone then North
nine and a quarter degrees
East one hundred and eighty
three and six tenths perches
to two Stones the corner for
that part of Upper Heathworth
called "Crown Bay" then with
