

The line between Readbourn and Brampton begins at the Stone established at the edge of the Marsh and runs thence S.E. by E or  $S56^{\circ}15' E$  and the Variation of  $3.45$  together make  $60$  - In running this line I found that  $60$  cuts and four chains or  $120$  perches brought us precisely to where coaks outside fence now stands.

Line of Brown's part of Brampton Beginning at the Stone of Readbourn and running thence to the River N.  $56^{\circ}15'$  <sup>west</sup>  $20$  perches then  $S20^{\circ} W$   $125$  perches then  $S56.15 E$   $159$  perches then  $N20^{\circ} E$   $125$  perches and from thence with a straight line to the Bay - Cont.  $8$   $124$  Acres more or less. On the  $N56.15 W$  and the  $S56.15 E$  courses Mr. Hackett allowed three degrees and the  $3/4$  Variation and on the other two courses he allowed
