THE several Regiments and Corps composing this Brigade will until otherwise ordered, meet for "exercise and inspection" on the same month and days of the month as heretofore, (the 21st or Chambers's excepted) to wit:

MASSEY'S, the 2nd, MONDAY in September; BAYNARD'S, the 3d MONDAY; TILGHMAN'S, the last MONDAY; the KENT ISLAND BATTALION the succeeding WEDNESDAY; the 21st, or CHAMBERS'S, the last SATURDAY in September.

The Commanding Officers of Squadrons of Cavalry will give the necessary Orders for the parade "exercise and inspection" of the several corps under their command with the Regiments to which they have heretofore been attached on days of exercise &c. CAPTAIN LASSELL'S ARTILLERY of Chestertown will parade uniformed and equipped with the 21st Regiment. The Brigade Major and Inspector will be furnished with blank returns and will attend (as the law directs) and inspect the several corps, taking care to receive the returns until they be strictly in form.
