-dred and Twenty Nine an Election was held by the Trus-
tees for the said district when the subscribers was duly
re-elected to that office namely, Dudley Clark Isaac
Baggs, Gouldsbury Price and Philimon Steiner Trustees
and Capt. Peter C. Suggs Collector a tax was voted on
the resident inhabitants ~~and~~ that the Trustees further report
that their school has been kept in the said district for
the last fifteen months and they have held their meetings
regular since their last report and further report that they
have received three hundred dollars, which has been
appropriated towards paying for teachers and that in
their last report they stated that there was in their district
sixty white children since they have ascertained that
there are from 75 to 80 white children residing in their
district between the ages of 5 and 15 and that there are from
45 to 50 white children taught in their district at
this time between the age of 5 and 15 years and further
report they have entered into a written contract with
Mr. William E. Langrell to teach their school for the
present year who is competent to teach Spelling, Reading,
writing arithmetic English Grammar Geography and the
Mathematics and also who is a young man of unimpeach-
able moral character as is manifested by his certifi-
cate of qualifications here with exhibited and we hope you
will afford us such assistance as your funds and the Law
will allow all of which is respectfully submitted by your
