

I know all Men by these Presents that I Benjamin Chew the younger
of the City of Philadelphia Executor of the last will and testament of
the Hon^{ble} William Tilghman late Chief Justice of the Common-
wealth of Pennsylvania deceased Do make constitute and appoint
Col^l: John Tilghman of Melfield in Queen Anne's County Maryland
my true and lawful Attorney for me and in my name to make
inventory of and to cause to be legally appraised all goods chattels
and personal property being part of or belonging to the estate of
the said William Tilghman deceased or to me as executor as
aforesaid or otherwise which are at or on the farm of the said
deceased situate in the Forest of Queen Anne commonly called
or known as the Forest farm

And to make in my behalf such
return or returns of the said inventory goods chattels or personal
property and of the appraisement thereof to the Orphans Court
of the said Queen Anne's County as is or are necessary and required
by law

And also to give all necessary directions and to take order
for the safe keeping arrangement or useful application of the said
goods chattels and personal property as I myself could or ought
lawfully to do

And also as soon as the said inventory appraise-
ment and return or returns shall have been admitted and
passed by the said Court to obtain an order of sale from the said
Court or if such order be not necessary according to the laws of
the State of Maryland then forthwith for me and in my
name after due advertisement to sell in legal form and
lawful manner all and every article item and part of the
said goods chattels or personal property which are at or on the
said Forest farm And to take receive and collect for me as
Executor as aforesaid all and every price sum or sums of money
or securities for which the said goods chattels or personal
property or any article or part thereof may be sold

And also to
make all bills of sale or conveyances and to give such receipts and
to make such delivery of property as may be necessary in conse-
quence of said sales

And also to obtain from the said Court
such ratification or approval of the sales of the said goods
chattels and personal property as is required by the laws of
Maryland And generally as my attorney to make do and
execute all matters and things which may be necessary and
lawful to carry into effect the powers hereby given to the
said John Tilghman And to do all lawful acts requisite
for effecting the premises Hereby ratifying and confirming
all
