Colo John Veleghman,

Sir,

I avail myself of the present opportunity to communicate to you full information in relation to your business under my control in this country.

Enclosed is a short statement of the amount of hire for the slaves, with the necessary expenses attending them.

The amt of the claim in the case of Postlethwaite

vs

Veleghman - was on the 1st day of Feby 1829 - fully paid by me - the sum paid then & 1828 - amount to \$3038.93/100 -

In the case of Lewis

vs

Veleghman - on the 1st Feby 1829 the sum of \$231.07 - was paid - & on the 1st Feby. 1830 - the sum of \$1323.32/100 - was paid in all \$1554.39/100 - in full of said claim.

For the negro girl Harriett, hired to Mrs Griffith for the year 1829 - I have not yet been paid the amount of her hire. One hundred dollars therefore is still due for this girl, & constitutes a part of the sum of \$1910 - Judge Turner, the administrator of Mrs Griffith, informed me to day that he would pay the \$100 - in a few days -
