Atty your favour of the 25th ult was handed me
this morning by Mr Clash and contents noticed

I herewith remit to you the amount of acct for
timber I had cut on Tilghmans Island say \$65.00 for which
I have taken Mr Clashs receipt which I hope will come safe

There is a man by the name of Josiah Bland formerly
a mail carrier for Mr Charles Rhoads who I am informed
now lives in your neighbourhood. He is indebted to me a small
sum for medicine and attendance on his wife. Will you be so good
as to have the account collected for me through one of your countables
I will have the acct put in order for collection and send it up
provided you will attend to it
