Dr Sir

I saw Mr Selby to day, he delivered to me your letter of the 12th of February and acknowledged that he had received from Colo Emory the amount that you mention in your letter. The posts and round rails that you want I will send to you before harvest & also the flat rails if I can possibly get them, but this I can positively agree to do, but as you do not wish them delivered until late in the season I think it is very likely I can supply ^{you} with them.
