in the shoe makers trade which he is so
gifted, that he is compelled to ask
assistance from the Public Store for his
subsistence - that he has no wife,
or any family of his own - Therefore
he prays, that this statement may be taken
into consideration and that he may be
allowed to draw rations from the Public
Store.
