

Parsonage. Nov^r 16th. 1840

Dear Sir

As I do not know who is the treasurer of our Church. and to whom I must apply for any portion of my salary. I will be very much obliged to you if you can advance me ten dollars - for my present use. which I will return as soon as I have the amount in hand. I do not wish to go at all in debt - or I might do without it. Neither do I wish to be troublesome to the vestry in asking for money before it is due. I hope I will not have to trouble you again upon this subject. - My expenses have been considerable in moving. and I have been disappointed in not receiving some money which is owing me. also I met with a small loss on the Millington Bank. - This is my apology in asking of you this favour -
