It will be necessary that I should be advised, before there is a final settlement, as to the correctness of the date of these payments. It is quite probable however, that they are so nearly correct as to make but little difference.

By reference to my letter of April 22nd 1837 covering a check on the Bank of Baltimore in full for the hire of the negroes, I think you will find a statement corresponding with the preceding one except as to the amount ascertained to be paid by Mrs Edgeman agreeable to the arrangement made with her.

My situation in the business has been any thing but pleasant. I have the satisfaction however of knowing that I have conscientiously discharged my duty to the best of my ability.

Mr Donaldson was furnished with a full statement of all the claims and to which our friend and relative Judge Bruce can have access if necessary.
