July 28th 1849.

Can you do me the favour to loan me ten dollars; I expect to leave home on Monday for a week or ten days & I am out of funds. I make this request reluctantly. Because I know you have many calls upon your kindness. I was in hopes to have received some money from the lower part of the parish. & thus, have been prevented the necessity I am now under of applying to a friend for help. out of 17 or 18 pew holders - only 7 paid their last half years pew rent - & to say nothing of back dues - & so I have to get along as well as I can -
