heirs, executors and administrators firmly by these pre-
sents, sealed with our seals and dated this day
of Eighteen hundred and thirty.

The Conditions of this obligation is such
that if a certain negro girl named Nancy, who
was sold to the above bound
by Benjamin Chesnut aforesaid, to serve for the term
of fifteen years from the first day of January in
the year Eighteen hundred and thirty, shall not be
removed out of the State of Delaware during his
