My masons returned

to me to make an estimate for a porch or portico
at your son James's House which I intended
doing but when I went to the Landing I found
I was too late to stop I have written to James
this morning to send me the size and height from
the ground and will send on bring an
estimate soon I have a house to build on
Longfords bay and could do it at the
same time

You will greatly oblige me
by sending me your check payable to
my order for \$150 as I must pay for the
stone freight and 6 in a few days the balance
we can settle when we meet
