

Baltimore April 16. 1845.

Sir,

Your favor of 15<sup>th</sup> inst was received today. I have examined again Dr Jones acct, and orders received from him up to May 45. There is charged to his acct. \$26.91 which agrees with his several orders. Then there is charged to the same acct. on July 5. Sundry Medicines amounting to \$6.16 which on reference to the order received of that date I find to have been ordered by Dr. Waitman Jones of the same place, but whom I now presume is Dr. J. Senior. I did not notice this distinction at the time and placed the acct. to Dr. J. Jr. Thus has arisen the mischarge which of course I am willing should be rectified and offer an apology to Dr. Jones Sr. it being an oversight on my part.
