Sixthly. I give and bequeath to my daughters Harriot Tilghman, Anna Catharine Tilghman and Mary Lloyd Tilghman all my Slaves on my Tilghmans Forest Farm, and all my Slaves on my Muddy Branch Farm, (except some few from the said Farms hereafter willed to my daughter Anna Maria Margaut Price) and I will and bequeath to my said daughters Harriot, Anna Catharine and Mary Lloyd all the live Stock of every kind plantation utensils and every other thing upon or appertaining to said two plantations, and the Crops of every sort growing thereon at the time of my decease and the Corn on the said Farms for the use thereof (the wheat if Cut to go into my Estate) —

Seventhly. I give and bequeath to my daughter Anna Maria Margaret Price, my chest of drawers painted or Japanned red and gold, my slave Emory who goes in the Schooner, her choice of six negroes among those on the Estate given to Harriot, Anna Catharine, and Mary Lloyd, the said six negroes to be of ages between Seventeen and thirteen, and I give and bequeath to my said daughter Anna Maria Price her choice of three negroes from the Estate given to my Son Matthew to be of ages as above. — And I give to my said daughter Anna Maria Margaret Price my negro man Jerry who is hired out in Kent County, and I request that the said negro may be sold or hired out so that he may live near to his wife. —

Eighthly. I give and bequeath to my daughter Harriot Tilghman my mulatto girl Debby, to my daughter Anna Catharine my mulatto girl Peggy daughter of Dick, to my daughter Mary Lloyd my mulatto Girl Harriot daughter of Dick —
