

Ninthly. I request my son Matthew Tilghman to bind Harry (the son of Richard) to a trade, and to manumit him at the age of Twenty six.

Tenthly. As I am considerably indebted and Bond or otherwise to sundry persons, I do hereby give and devise to my son Matthew Tilghman my Land in Dorchester County it being a moiety of a tract of Land called the Grove (and now under rent to Capt. Eleventhly. I remit to my daughter Anna Maria Margaret Price the five hundred pounds which I have charged to her on my Books, and any other charges that there may appear on my Books against her.

Twelfthly. After my just debts and funeral expences are paid, should there be a Balance of my Estate remaining, I direct that the same be equally divided among

Thirteenthly. I give to my son Matthew Two hundred pounds and request him to accept the same in lieu of legal commissions on the settlement of my Estate.

Lastly. I do hereby constitute and appoint my son Matthew Tilghman Executor of this my last will and Testament, hereby revoking and annulling all
