This Machine is warranted to be of good material and well made, and if properly operated will cut from ten to fifteen acres of grain or grass per day, with two horses and driver, (and if a Self-Raker, to do its own raking as well as it can be done by hand, and if a Dropper, as well as any other Dropper,) and cut any kind of grass as well as any other Combined Machine, and if a single Reaper to reap as well as any other Reaper. It is expressly understood that this Warranty is invalid and of no effect unless the Machine is properly set up and operated as per our printed directions.

If said Machine does not perform as above, immediate notice must be given to L. H. LEE & BRO., Baltimore, Md.; subject to a second trial in their presence, when if the failure is found to have arisen from want of mechanical skill in operating the Machine, it shall be kept by the purchaser; but if upon a second trial said Machine does not work as above, it may be returned to us and the money will be refunded.
