MONDAY. (Standard.) Dark gray colt; foaled March 23, 1885. By TENNESSEE WILKES.

First dam Sue Munday, by PILOT JR., sire of the dams of Maud S., 2:08½, and Jay-Eye-See, 2:10.

Second dam Kate Tabor, by Mambrino Messenger.

Third dam, a gray trotting mare of unknown pedigree, bred on Long Island.

Pilot Jr., is sire of nine horses in 2:30 list, and of the dams of twenty others.

Mambrino Messenger (sire of General George H. Thomas and grandsire of Scott's Thomas, 2:21) was by Mambrino Paymaster, sire of Mambrino Chief, out of a mare by Coffin's Messenger, son of Imp. Messenger.

No. 54.

SANTIAGO. Bay colt, without white; foaled May 23, 1885. By DICTATOR, sire of Jay-Eye-See, 2:10; Phallas, 2:13½.

First dam LADY ESTILL by CLARK CHIEF, sire of the dams of Phallas, 2:13½, Majolica, 2:15, etc.

Second dam, by EDWIN FORREST, sire of Billy Hoskins, 2:26½.

This colt, it will be observed, is bred like Phallas, holder of the best stallion record, both being by Dictator out of daughters of Clark Chief. He is the joint property of Major H. C. McDowell and myself, and is now at Ashland, near Lexington, Kentucky.

WALLENSTEIN. (Standard.) Dark gray colt, with left hind ankle white around hoof; foaled April 27, 1885. By TENNESSEE WILKES.

First dam Gray Fanny, by PILOT JR.

Second dam Jenny Lind, by John Democrat, son of Kentucky Whip.

Third dam, by a son of Copperbottom.

Pilot Jr. sired nine horses in the 2:30 list, and the dams of Maud S., 2:08½, and Jay-Eye-See, 2:10.

No. 56.

ARGOT. Dark bay colt, no marks; foaled May, 1886. By TENNESSEE WILKES.

First dam Sally Ward, by Bennett (pacer).

Second dam Sweepstakes, by Dudley's Snow Heel (pacer).

Third dam Kit, by the Old or McMeens' Traveler.

Bennett, by Pat Malone (pacer), dam a saddle mare of untraced blood.

Dudley's Snow Heel is the same as Knight's Snow Heel, he by Knight's Tom Hal.

Old Traveler (sire of Joe Bowers, 2:32, and of the dam of Geo. Gordon, 2:27½, and grandsire of Joe Bowers Jr., 2:18), by the thoroughbred stallion, Stump the Dealer, son of Timoleon (sire of Boston).

Argot was bred by N. B. Cheairs, Esq., Spring Hill, Tenn., and bought of him.

No. 57.

BASTION. (Standard.) Bay colt, with large star in face, both hind legs white above ankles; foaled May 26, 1886. By TENNESSEE WILKES.

First dam BESSIE TAYLOR, by ENFIELD, 2:29.

Second dam Minnie Clyde, by BRIGNOLI, 2:29½.

Third dam, by Gano, sire of the dam of Lady Thorn and Mambrino Patchen.

Fourth dam, by Potomac.

Fifth dam, by Baronet.

Enfield (sire of Robin M., 2:24½, and full brother to Chester, 2:27) is by Rysdyk's Hambletonian, sire of forty horses in 2:30 list. Enfield's dam, Julia Machree, is full sister to Widow Machree, 2:29, by American Star. Enfield is bred like Dictator and Startle, and is full brother in blood to Aberdeen.

Brignoli (Mambrino Prince) is by Mambrino Chief. He sired the dams of King Wilkes, 2:22½, and six other horses in 2:30 list.

Bred at Ewell Farm.
