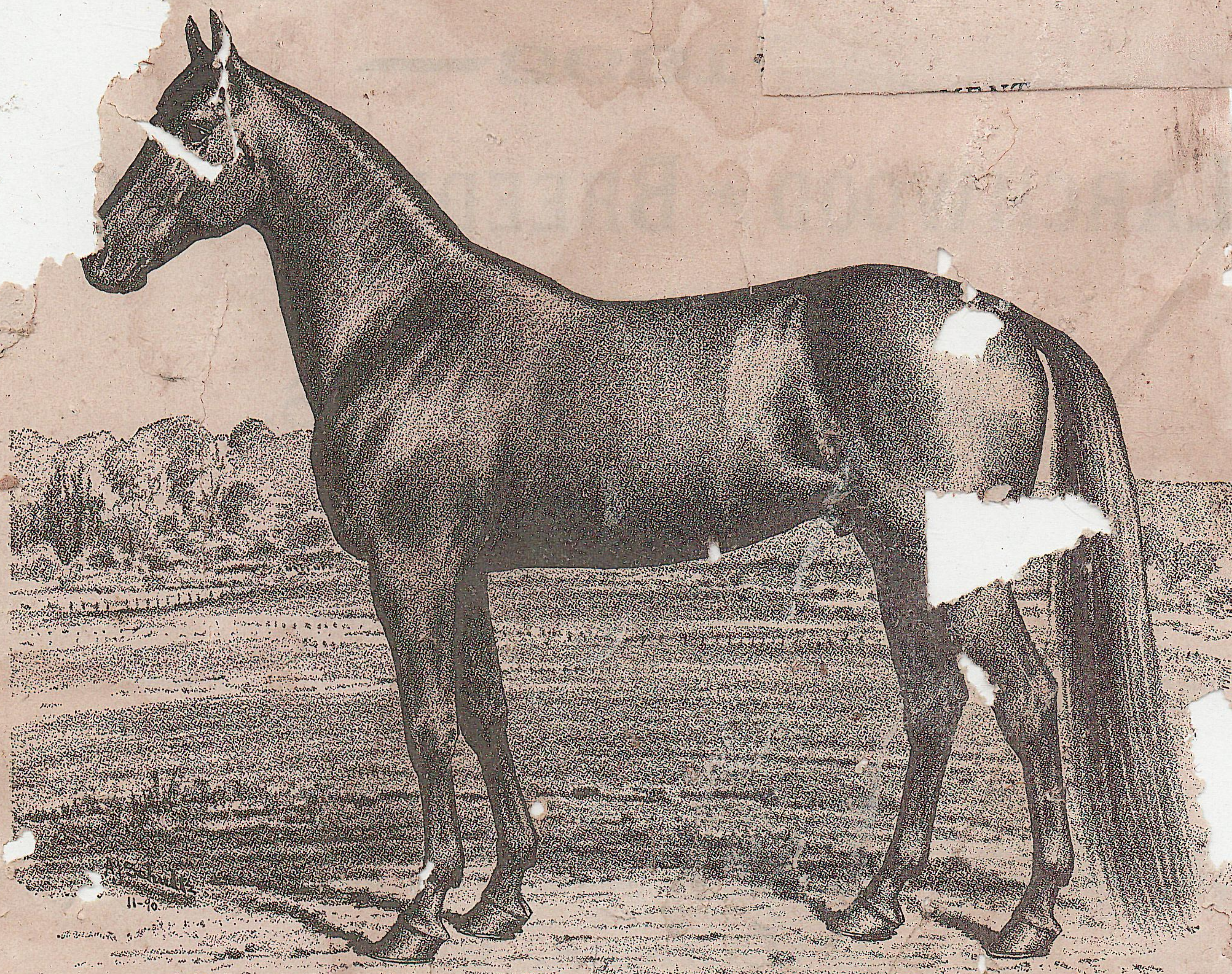




PETREL, 10946

PETREL.

Foaled April 6, 1888; sire, Sphinx; dam by Louis Napoleon, son of Volunteer, and Hattie Wood. Sphinx (2:20½, sire of Gift O'Neer, 2:24½ at 2 years) is one of the best bred and most promising sons of Electioneer, his dam Sprite, by Belmont, being the dam of 3 in the list, and her dam Waterwitch, by Pilot Jr., being the dam of 5. Petrel's dam, a young daughter of Louis Napoleon (the sire of 8 new performers in 1891), reinforces the potent blood of Electioneer, and these great dams, by the addition of two strains to Volunteer, one of the best lines to Hambletonian 10, while his second and third dams trace direct to this great fountain-head through two other producing sons, giving him 6 crosses to Hambletonian 10. Petrel has unexceptional individuality combined with great promise of speed.
