

8. Two years. Plowed the field or early in the Spring preceding.

9. 25 to 30 two horse cart loads. of good Stable
manure.

10. Consumed by the 7th June.

11. From 2500 to 3000 ^{lb} for a new beginning.

12. While tobacco is at the present price, and what
ever at 1.50 ^{cts} the tobacco crop is the best to be
of the principal crops.

13. It is best to check out and with two or 3 shakes of the
hoe make a little hill. 5 to 6000 hills can be
made per day.

14. The hills should be 3 ft. or riding land and in
a long strong row 3 ft. 4 in. The large plants are
always because the quantity is greater.

The Burly tobacco is best and it should be topped to
from 16 to 20 leaves to the plant. It will be finer
if it is not topped till the blossom is developed.
The thickest is the 10th kind.

15. The grower should have cognizance of the
whole operation. The best judge among the
hands is to take off the lower inferior to be
the next best, the best quality, and the most
different hands the top.

16. There has not been a sufficient experiment
with Stover to speak positively of them.
There are said to answer very well.
