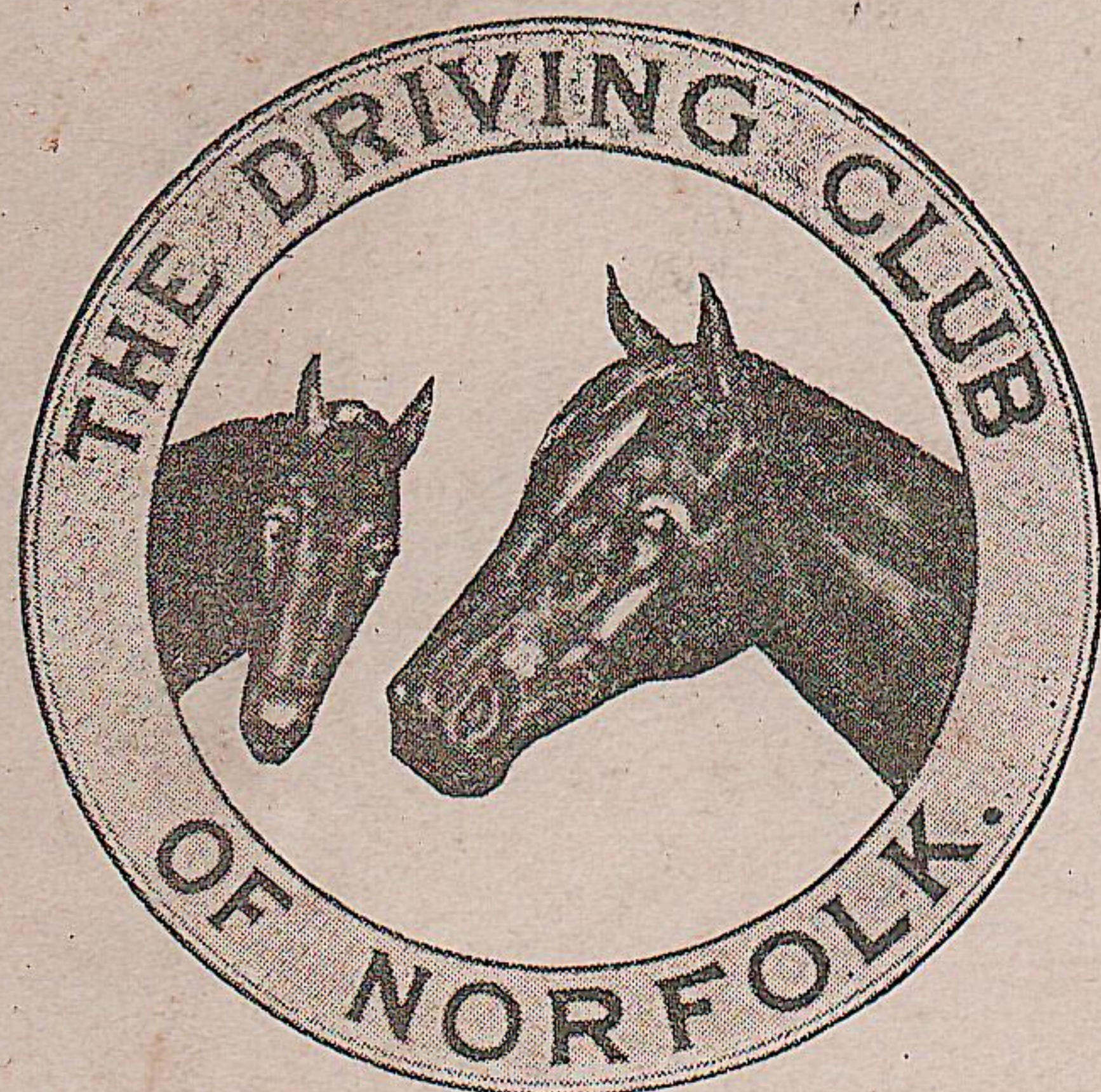
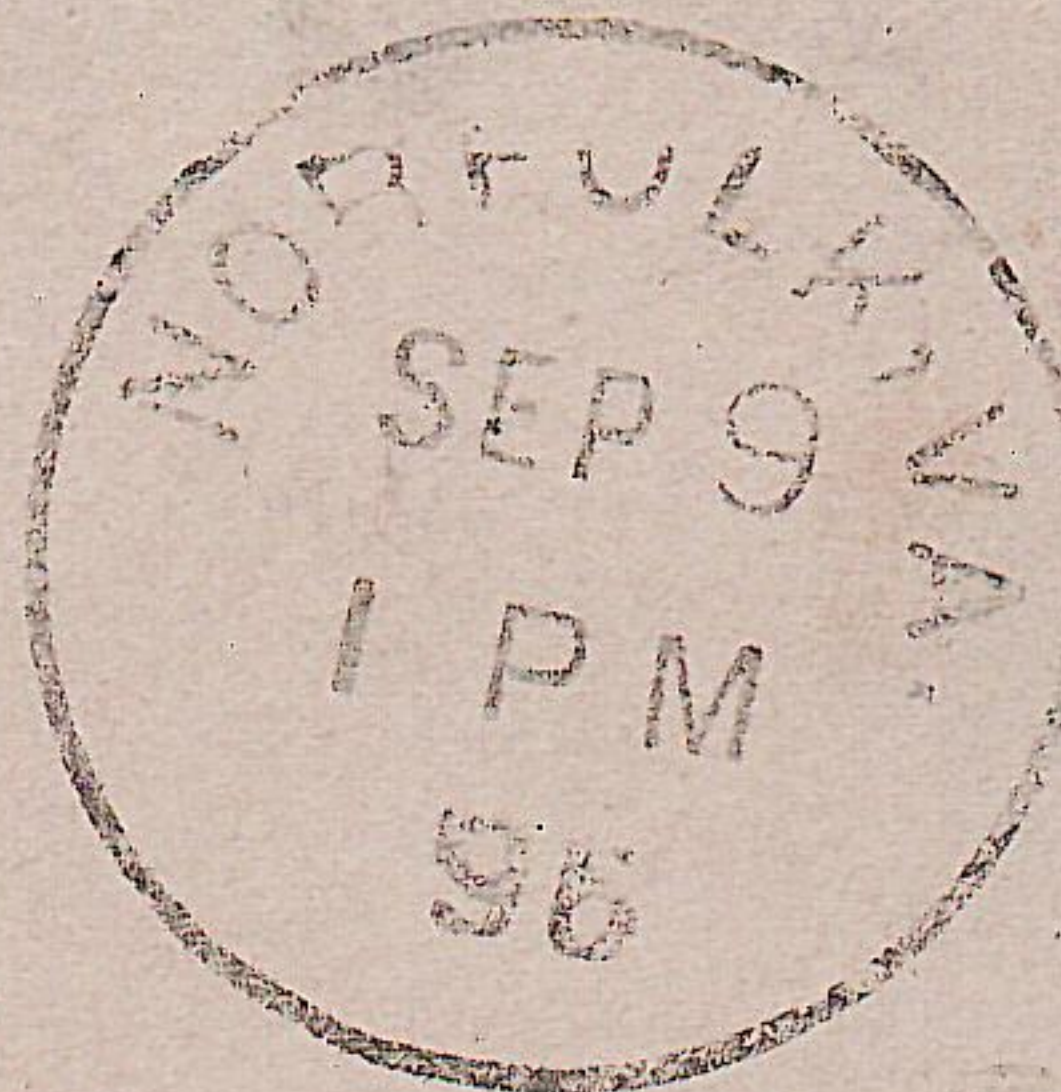

CONDITIONS.

National Association Rules. All races in harness, mile heats, best 3 in 5. Money divided 50, 25, 15 and 10 per cent. Entrance fee, 5 per cent. and 5 per cent. additional from money winners. A horse distancing the field gets one money only. Five to enter, four to start. Right reserved to change order of any day's program. Right reserved to reject any entry which is not received within 24 hours after the date of closing. Always give Post Office address.

Remember, Entries close Tuesday, Sept. 22nd, at 11 P. M. Records made that day no bar. No conditional entries will be received.

Old Distance rules will be enforced.
