RULES AND REGULATIONS.

This Association being a member of the National Trotting Association, all trotting will be conducted under the rules and regulations of the National Trotting Association, and all running races under the American Jockey Club's rules, as last amended, except as modified by the regulations of this Association.

Races called each day at 12:30; start promptly at 1 p. m. The Board reserves the right to change the program, and to declare any race or races off on account of bad weather, the entrance fee for races so declared off to be refunded. A horse distancing the field will receive first money only. One dollar a day will be charged owners who make no entries for each horse occupying a stall. Old distance rules to govern.

ENTRIES.

- Observe these rules in making entries.
1. All entries for Trotting and Pacing races will be closed on Saturday, October 17th at 11 p. m. Running entries close at 6 o'clock p. m. the day preceding the event.
 2. Entrance fee 5 per cent. of purse except when otherwise specified. Horses taking 1st, 2d, 3d, or 4th, money in any race will be charged 5 per cent. additional.
- Entrance fee for horses for event of Tuesday must be paid before 1 o'clock noon on Monday, the 19th; for events of Wednesday before the same hour on Tuesday, the 20th; for events on Thursday before the same hour on Wednesday, the 21st; for events on Friday before the same hour on Thursday, the 22nd. If not so paid, horses may not be permitted to start and may be suspended by the judges for non payment.
4. In all events five must enter and three must start. Races in harness to be in mile heats, 3 in 5, except when otherwise designated.
 5. Name number of races in which the animals are entered.
 6. State color, sex and name of animal.
 7. Give name of sire and dam. If same are not known the fact must be stated when the entry is made.
 8. If the animal has trotted under another name within two years the former name must also be given.
 9. Entries made by telegraph, should also be repeated by mail.
 10. Name and residence of owner as well as the party making the entry, must always be given with the nomination.
 11. Owners and drivers not giving colors when entries are made, will accept those designated by the Association.
 12. Rules as to weights and weighing will be enforced.
 13. No record made after October 15th, will be a bar.
 14. No conditional entries accepted.
