

The toe and heel calks have the proper proportion of material to ensure even wear.

In size they compare with the regular standard Light Pattern; in weight they are lighter than the Light shoe before the latter has been fitted; and their cost compared with the same sizes in a pair, or two shoes, is:—

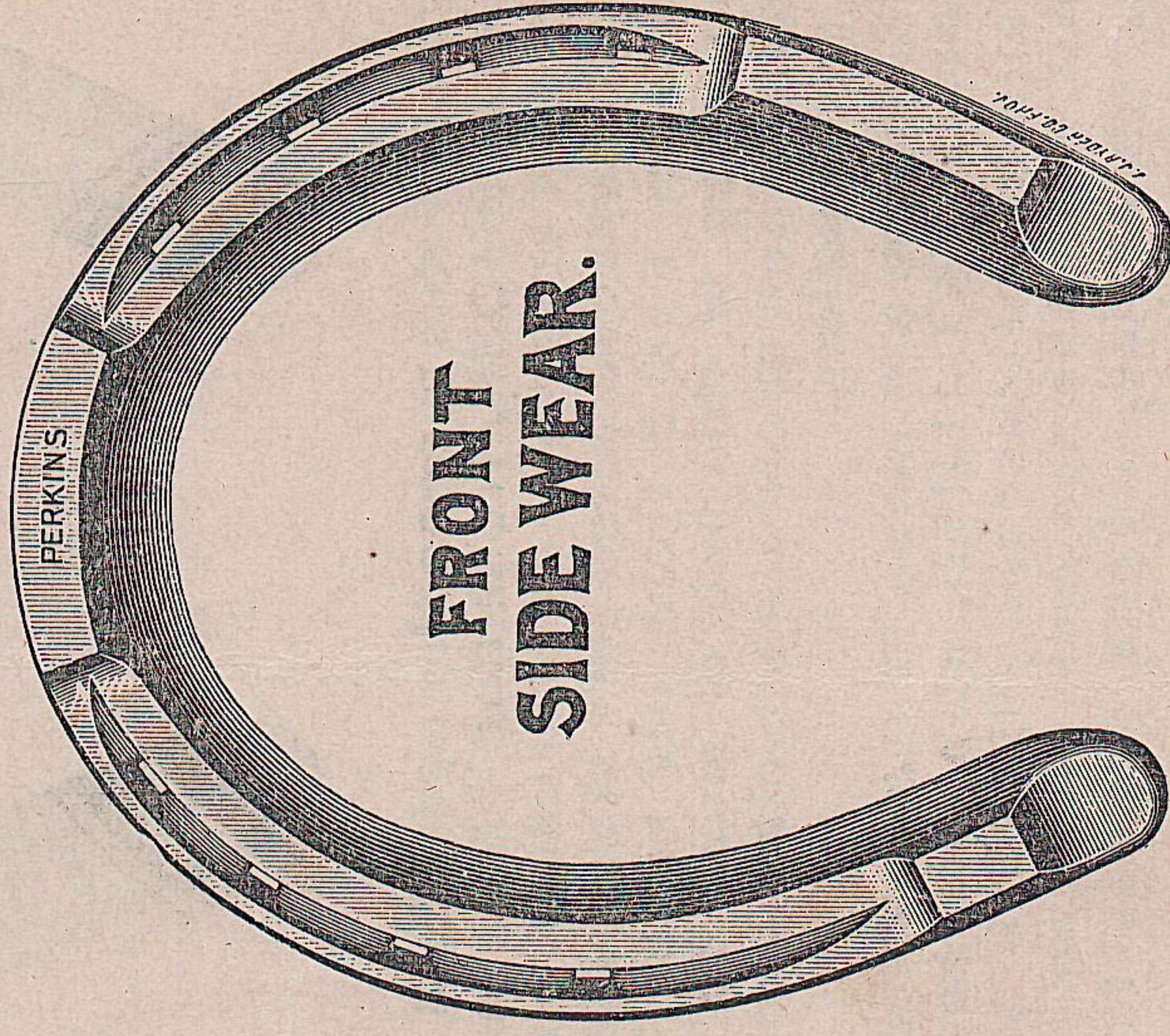
One pair No. 2 Front Calked Shoes cost same as one pair No. 2 Front Light not fitted.

One pair No. 2 Front Side Wear Shoes cost 1 ct. more than one pair No. 2 Front Light not fitted.

One pair No. 2 Hind Calked Shoes cost 1 ct. more than one pair No. 2 Hind Light not fitted.

One pair No. 2 Hind Side Wear Shoes cost 2 cts. more than one pair No. 2 Hind Light not fitted.
