Known all men by these presents that I, Woodman
Gibson of Queen Anns County in the State of Maryland
am held and firmly bound unto Eleanor S Goldsborough
of Talbot County in the same State, guardian to her
her infant children, in the sum of six thousand
dollars lawful money, to be paid to the said Elea-
nor S. Goldsborough or her certain attorney, his execu-
tors administrators or assigns; to which payment
will and truly to be made, I bind myself my heirs
executors and administrators, firmly by these pre-
sents: Sealed with my Seal and dated this
thirtieth day of September eighteen hundred
and sixty two.

The condition of the above obligation is
such, that if the above bound Woodman Gibson
his heirs executors or administrators do and shall
will and truly pay or cause to be paid, unto the above
named Eleanor S Goldsborough her executors ad-
ministrators or assigns the full sum of three
thousand dollars lawful money on or before the
thirtieth day of September in the year eigh-
teen hundred and sixty five, and also legal
interest on the said sum of three thousand
dollars semi annually on the first days of Jan-
uary and July in each and every year until
the said sum of three thousand dollars prin-
ciple shall be paid; then this obligation to be
void otherwise to be and remain in full force
and virtue.
