executor of P. J. Cook to cultivate the
corn crop now standing on the farm where
said Cook lived at the time of his decease
in a farmerlike manner, and to raise
and put up the top fodder therefrom in
good order on the premises, ~~and~~ to deliver
to the order of said Tilghman at the
Centerville landing two fifths of the ^{said} crop
of corn in such marketable order ready for
market, before the twentieth day of Decem-
ber next. The top fodder raised from
the said crop to be paid ^{to me} for by the pur-
chaser of the farm at a given valuation.
