Whereas W^m Thorne of Calvert, has by his humble Petition to his
Ex^{ty} Deputy for Management of the Land affairs, set forth that
he is possessed of a certain tract of Land in the County containing
Eleven hundred acres and originally surveyed the thirteenth day
of November one thousand Six hundred fifty and three for
John Smith, W^m Robinson, and George Wallis, and that upon
inspection into the list of the said Land he finds that the Sur-
vey in the second line thereof has by mistake returned a
South East line instead of an East and by South line to make
the Survey altogether incorrect. Wherefore he prayed that he
might have a warrant to Resurvey the said Land, in Directions to
the Surveyor to amend the said Mistake, and that if upon such
Resurvey any Surplus Land be found within the Bounds thereof
he may have his Ex^{ty} Grant for the same upon such terms
as to the Ex^{ty} should seem convenient in case he should find him

Lay out the said Land for and in the name of the said W^m Thorne the said
tract of Land according to the true Ancient meter and Bounds thereof
making the said South East line an East and by South line. Provided
that in so doing you run not through the list of any other Survey
not running any other of your land within the limits of any former or
more ancient Survey or Land returned for the said W^m Thorne and returned
your Certificate of such your Resurvey to an Ex^{ty} at or of the Surplus
if any into his Ex^{ty} Land office at the Court of Annapolis by the
thirteenth day of August next to be from thence transmitted to the
Ex^{ty} Grace for his Examination. Whereupon the Ex^{ty} Deputy
will further do as to Right shall appear. W^m at the said
Court of Annapolis under his Ex^{ty} Letter Bled at arms the
thirteenth day of February 1695
