

In the year eighteen Hundred and Eleven There were a

In Consequence of which Reports coming to my hearing
I applied to W O'Fly to know if he had ever circulated
such a Report, which he denied & gave me the following
Certificate "I do hereby Certify to all whom it may concern
that I never heard Thomas Segar say that he or any other
person had found or knew of any Will left by Mark Benton
deceased? But I have heard him express an anxious
wish that if any Will left that it might be found."

I Certify also that no person did tell Vernon Benton nor
other person that Thomas Segar had told me he knew of
any Will left by Mark Benton Given under my
hand this 9 day of May 1811
