1814 To 1 Batteau and set of Oars ----- \$ 20.00

This is to Certify that I was Called on by Doctor Jacob Ringgold some time in the summer of 1814 at the time the British lay off Hunt Island to lend him a Batteau which belonged to Mr. Tho^s Sugar to go to Baltimore in, I told him I could not lend her, but if he thought proper to take her he could do so, he replied he would and if he did not return her he would be answerable to Mr. Sugar for the value of her and to the best of my knowledge she has not been returned - Witness my hand this 15th day of June Eighteen hundred and sixteen

On the 15th day of June 1816 Thomas Sugar made Oath on the Holy Evangel^s of Almighty God before me the Subscriber One of the Justices of the peace for the County aforesaid, That the above Batteau and Oars hath never been returned or accounted to him for, And that no part or parcel of the above account hath been paid or any security or satisfaction Received for the same
