Dear Sir,

At the late meeting of the Governor and Council, your own appointed a commissioner, in conjunction with Charles Stuart Ridgely Esq. of Anne Arundell County, and John B Howard Esq. of Baltimore County, to enter the limits of direct taxation, within the City of Baltimore, so far as the same is settled, built or improved, and in which the usual regulations for watching and lighting, or cleaning the Streets, are, or ought to be, applied: as provided for by an act passed by the last General Assembly, entitled "An additional act relating to the City of Baltimore."

A Joint Commission has been issued and forwarded to the City of Baltimore, to the care of the Mayor.
