M. Helen Owen, by her next friend Henry C. Newman,  
by way of Supplementary Answer to the Petition in the  
above entitled cause respectfully represents —

That when she filed her answer to the Petition of the  
Complainants therein she consented to the appointment of  
Trustees to take charge of her share of the estate of her  
Grandfather E. F. Chambey deceased, merely in the hope  
of avoiding unpleasant litigation, and with no idea that  
there would or could be any opposition to her nomination  
of proper persons to fill that position, who would be  
personally satisfactory to her. She respectfully submits  
that there is no provision in the Codicil to the will of her  
said Grandfather, under which she takes, looking to  
or directing the appointment of any trustee whatever, and  
that there is no legal right in the Petitioner, or any one  
else to call on your Honor to appoint one. She alleges,  
however, that since the filing of her answer aforesaid,  
exceptions to the appointment of those suggested by her,  
as said Trustees have been filed, signed by D. Sutton  
and L. C. Sutton, setting forth, in detail, reasons both  
offensive and trivial, why her reasonable wishes in the
