Should your Honor, however, against the respectful contention of your Respondent, as aforesaid, see fit to determine that the appointment of a Trustee or Trustees is required by Law to be made in the premises, Your Respondent renews her recommendation of her brother the said Wyatt Owen, and her solicitor D. James Blackiston Esq., for such Trusteeship & prays that your Honor appoint them accordingly, and she will ever pray &c
