

- A.D. 1670. "Captain Wm. Hensley," was Clerk of Talbot County.
 1682. He died leaving a widow "Judith" & four sons.
 1684. "William Hensley Jr." married Cornelia Note. Widow
 1692. Judith Hensley died - leaving her sons Phil^{ms} & Vincent & Esta.
 1699. Wm Hensley Jr. died leaving a widow Jane & one daughter
 Elizabeth Hensley who inherited the Hopton Estate
 160 Acres - & is supposed to have died unmarried -
 He also left his wife Jane a large Tract supposed to
 be "Clover Fields" & others in all 976 Acres -
 Some years ago he executed a deed of gift to
 Vincent & Charles - of 1260 acres
 now Paca's Island. -
 1700. Philimon Hensley - was a share & that of his Brother
 Charles (who did a Bachelor in foreign parts) to
 Philimon Lloyd & then removed to Charles Co. - Who
 he married is ~~not~~ not known -
 1719. "Philimon Hensley" died leaving as we suppose one son
 William & one daughter Judith -
 "William Hensley 3^d" married Anna Maria Silghman.
 1736. He died at the age of 33 - leaving a widow & 4 children
 was buried where he had lived at Clover Fields in Tal. Co.
 "Anne Hensley" Eldest daughter of "Wm H. 3^d" died single -
 "Mary" 2^d " " died early unmarried.
 1756. Philimon Hensley Eldest son of "Wm H. 3^d" died at
 the Temple London, where he was a Student at
 Law - Aged 24 yrs. - Unmarried -
 "Wm Hensley 4th" a posthumous son of "Wm H. 3^d"
 married "Henrietta Maria Earl" who left 3 children
 afterwards Sarah Williamson, who left 9 children
 & lastly Anna M Silghman who survived him -
 1812. Wm Hensley 4th died at Clover Fields -
 Wm Hensley 5th Eldest Son of the above married Maria
 Lloyd who died in the first year of their marriage -
 He died -
 1825. Philimon Hensley 2^d son of W. H. 4th married
 1804. Elizabeth Lloyd - who died leaving 2 children -
 "Thomas" 2^d son of W. H. 4th married
 who survived him - He left
 Alexander Hensley 4th son married Henrietta
 Silghman, who died early leaving 2 children -
 2^d married Elizabeth Ann West
