

This indenture made the 26th day of March 1774 between Nathan Jackson of Kent County in Md. planter and Mary his wife, which Mary was the widow of David Register late of Queen Anne's County in Maryland, deceased, of the one part and John Register Emory of Queen Anne's County Af^d devisee of the said David Register of the other part - transfer of Mary's rights of dower etc in 100 acres of Smith's Mistake

Coursey's Point -

Sept 17 1658. Laid out for Henry Coursey of this province, Gentleman a tract of land lying on East side of Chester River and on north side of a creek in the said river called Corica Creek. 1350 acres

October 14 } David Register, of Queen Anne's Co, blacksmith, to
1762 } John Register Emory, planter, £ 300 - all that part of Brampton - which he Register purchased of a certain Jane Hawkins in 1759 - being 126 acres, (except one quarter of an acre where the graveyard is on said land) situated lying and being in Kings Town, and also one lot (1 acre) in Kings Town in same County
David Register signed his own name.
