I have for some years been interested particularly in the early history of our family and I have nearly completed a very accurate and I think interesting set of notes on the Maryland Emory genealogy, with special reference to my own, the "Poplar Grove" branch.

One of my grandfathers, John Emory 1740, was a brother of Charles Emory, father of John M.G. Emory of your branch. They were the grandsons of Arthur, who came to Maryland in 1660.

I was very fortunate recently in securing the notes, records, original colonial documents, etc., from the widow of my cousin, the late Frederick Emory of the State Department. His correspondence and notes on this work show that he spent some twenty years in the matter of research and collection of family data.

I have succeeded during the past year in adding considerable new data and have been quite successful in throwing some new light on our ancestors in England and have in connection with my own branch
