Mr Clayland

Dear Sir I went out to the store and looked at the ~~House~~ it is 29 ft long but the Roof will not have as much fall as I would like for it to have but still I think I can make it without leakage though the low part of the shed will not be more than  $5\frac{1}{2}$  or 6 ft inside and 8 ft high at high part it will make 2 rooms and a pantry and I will ~~try and~~ do it for \$210 - \$100 of which I will want when job is finished and balance by 10th December if you can so arrange it I shall endeavour to make a good job of it so as to give you satisfaction. would it not be better to make one of the Rooms larger than the other Mr Stong and myself thinks so but I leave that with you. the Pantry of course will be shelved and all the Doors to have locks and the inside plastered and I think there ought to be a door between the two Rooms as also an outside door and two doors leading out from Main Building which will make ~~of~~ new doors and one old one and two windows I shall wait to hear from you before I commence. I would say to you that when you Build. that these Rooms can be moved on the materials could be used in other Buildings hoping to hear from you soon I remain yours very Respectfully
