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FIVE POINTS will be added to the examination average of the non-promotional candidate who:

1. Has been a resident of Maryland for one year immediately prior to filing application *or* has been a resident of Maryland for the one year, or two out of three years, immediately preceding entry into military service.
2. Has no conviction for a violation of law, other than a minor traffic violation.
3. Who has had OFFICIAL PROOF verified and cleared, and received letter showing our registration number and date.
4. Has a minimum of 90 days service during one of the following periods: April 6, 1917 to November 11, 1918; May 1, 1940 to December 31, 1946; June 1, 1950 to June 1, 1959; or has served sometime during 1965, 1966 and 1967 in a military combat area or zone outside the continental limits of the United States; or is eligible to receive the expeditionary Forces Medal (Executive Order #10977) or the Vietnam Service Medal (Executive Order #11231).

TEN POINTS will be added to the examination average of the non-promotional candidate who:

5. Is a disabled veteran or the wife of a totally disabled veteran, with service incurred disability and who, in addition to the proof noted under items 1 through 4, has submitted a certificate issued by the Veterans Administration DURING THE PAST SIX MONTHS.
6. Is the widow of a veteran and has not remarried. In addition to the proof noted under above items 1 through 4, widows must submit proof of marriage to, and death of, deceased veteran.
