in Patent

in consideration that will Hensley of
the County of Talbot in our Province of Maryland
hath due unto him Two Hundred and Fifty
Acres of Land within our said Province part of
a warrant for Twelve Hundred + Fifty acres of
land to the said Hensley formerly granted as
appears upon record and upon such conditions
and terms as are expressed in our conditions
of Plantation of our said Province of Maryland
under our greater Seal at Anno bearing date
at London the second day of July in the year of
our Lord God 1649 with such alterations as
in them is and by our Declaration bearing
date the 22 day of September Anno 1658 and
remaining upon record in our said Province of
Maryland do hereby grant unto him the said
William Hensley all that parcel of land
called Brampton lying on Chester River in
Talbot Co - Beginning at a marked Oak
being the bounded Tree of a parcel of land
formerly laid out for George Reade and
running down the river for breadth one
Hundred twenty-five perches to marked oak
bounded on the South with a sure (?) draw
