SUPPLEMENT

to Estimate Circular No. 2.

Referring to Estimate Circular No. 2, covering unit prices for estimating on final location, the prices therein contained are applicable only to points in Pennsylvania lying west of the Allegheny Mountain summit. For all estimating purposes between the Allegheny mountains and the Lehigh River use the following unit prices:

Earth excavation.....	30¢ per cu. yd.
Loose rock ".....	None
Solid rock ".....	85¢

2. In the absence of soundings or other definite method for obtaining classification, we will consider a 10' strip of earth overlying the solid rock.

For points in New Jersey between the Delaware and Lehigh Rivers and the Hudson River, we will use the following unit prices for gradation:

Earth and loose rock excavation.....	33¢ per cu. yd.
Solid rock excavation.....	80¢

3. In the absence of definite advice as to classification, we will assume 40% as earth and loose rock excavation and 60% as solid rock excavation.
