

(3) (Kaiser mine Report)

from the Hickson - Dallas Road to Harrison Ferry. (see topographic map attached) It ~~extends~~ from near the road, across a low N.W.-S.E. spur ridge to a little cultivated valley beyond. The developed deposit is in a saddle on this ridge about 600 ft from the main road.

Topography + Geology

Looking at the topographic map it will be seen that the main ridge of which the property is a spur, is a continuation of Missionary Ridge on the North side of the Tennessee River.

The country is timbered with large second growth chestnut + chestnut oak and from surface indications the underlying formation is Fort Payne chert. Chert float covers the surface of the ground and outcrops of dark blue lime stone were noted along the Hickson - Dallas Rd in the vicinity.
