(b) It arbitrarily fails to make shipments of aluminum ingots to its competitors or to the competitors of its subsidiaries at the time said products are ordered or at the time specified for shipment.

(c) It arbitrarily makes deliveries of aluminum or aluminum ingots to its competitors or to the competitors of its subsidiaries in insufficient quantities or in amounts or quantities less than ordered.

(d) It makes delivery of aluminum sheets or aluminum ingots to its competitors or to the competitors of its subsidiaries of quality inferior to that required.

THE EXAMINER: You are reading from the complaint?

MR. WHITELEY: Yes.

THE EXAMINER: And you have been attempting to prove these allegations in the complaint. It is my holding, gentlemen, that the procedure that the Commission has followed in including in its complaint is right and proper and that the respondent is only bound to answer in its side of the case the allegations as set forth in the two charges mentioned in the complaint under Section 5 and Section 2.
