

A Yes, and that was not worrying us particularly.

Q You didn't like the large amount of work involved in this new industry?

A It came right down to that."

MR. WHITELEY: Now, Mr. Examiner, as long as that testimony has been read at some length it is rather apparent that there must have been some reason not stated by the witness for not continuing in the starting of this industry and even assuming that the witness' testimony was entirely frank, certainly the Commission is entitled to have before it the full facts with regard to what was done by this respondent in its efforts first to prevent this possible competitor acquiring bauxite and second in the matter of buying out them whenever they were unsuccessful in the first instance. And while the complaint does charge that the respondent has employed and is still employing a scheme the purpose and effect of which was and is to gain and maintain a monopoly in these various products from the raw material down to the manufactured products, a monopoly throughout the United States, certainly is proved. That in furtherance of that scheme it secured valuable bauxite deposits in other parts of the world in order to prevent the manufacture¹² in the United States from securing that material for the manufacture of aluminum and we submit that would be competent, relevant and material.
